

When will I find out what ministry tract I will be in?

The ministry tract list will be sent out about a week before CityReach. Be looking for this info via email.

What materials and supplies will we as youth pastors be responsible for?

- Be prepared to use your vehicle for the transportation of students to project sites daily. If you have a van or bus it will be very helpful for transportation.
- Large water coolers will be helpful at project sites.
- Students are required to wear closed-toe shoes (athletic shoes, boots, etc.) to their work site. The only exception is carwash.

What will my adult leaders do everyday?

If the adults did not pick a ministry project, they may feel free to join a team where they are needed. We ask that adults participate in everything involved with CityReach (ministry tract, worship, meetings, etc.)

What will youth pastors do at CityReach?

Youth Pastors need to attend all scheduled meetings. Youth Pastors will serve as leaders during ministry tracts. You will work along side students in order to build relationships and provide leadership. Also youth pastors will be asked to share the gospel throughout the week when the opportunity arises. Please be available to step in and serve where needed.

What about transportation?

Do to the nature of CityReach we ask that churches be prepared to use their vehicles for the transportation of students during CityReach. Students will be transported from the Rowan University campus to the project site. As well as to the lunch site. Transportation plans will be set the week of CityReach.

What about children or preschoolers?

There will be no childcare provided at CityReach. For children who are in the 1st – 6th grade, they are welcome to join the Sports Camp. The Sports Camp will take place Monday – Thursday. Where will we be lodging while at Rowan University?

All lodging will be in dorm housing. Dorms will be split by gender. All rooms are equipped with one or two beds, desk/dresser, and closet.

What should my students wear everyday?

CityReach is a casual event. The biggest concern is what will be worn during the ministry tracts Monday – Thursday. Please make sure you inform your students of their ministry tract so they can pack accordingly. Those who will be in special ops should consider wearing clothes they do not care to get dirty. Also students are required to wear closed-toe shoes (athletic shoes, boots, etc.) to their work site. The only exception is carwash. For more info, a packing list is available on the home page.

Where do we go when we get to Swedesboro, NJ?

Everyone will be staying at Rowan University. Check in and registration will take place at the Edgewood Park Apartments. All maps can be downloaded from the website by clicking the Maps and Directions link.

What will we be doing on Saturday afternoon?

Everyone will be traveling to the Jersey Shore for team building, beach time, and worship. CityReach will provide an evening meal on the beach.

Who can participate?

Students who have completed the 9th – the 12th grade. CityReach is designed for these students in mind.

Can I bring college students?

Yes. However please remember that CityReach is designed for High School students.

When do I have to pay?

- Payment 1: \$100 deposit per person is due before Feb. 1 with registration forms. If received after Feb. 1 the deposit is \$125.
- Payment 2: \$280 (per person) due by April 1.

Payment can be made by check. The full cost of CityReach 2010 is \$380. Late registration is \$400.

What does the fee cover?

Lodging while in Swedesboro, NJ
All meals while in Swedesboro, NJ, except for Friday night.
Construction materials or project supplies
Highly Qualified Worship Band and Speaker
CityReach bag

What if I need to cancel students or make substitutions?

We know that this happens. Please contact Jason Wait with any changes to your original registration.

Can I add people later?

Absolutely – Provided CityReach has not reached full capacity. Since CityReach can reach maximum capacity we suggest you register everyone early.

Can I arrive late or leave early?

Please avoid late arrival or early departure at all cost. We want students and leaders to get the full experience of CityReach. If you cannot avoid it please contact someone on the CityReach team.

Do my students need to go through any training prior to CityReach?

On the schedule you will see that ministry tract prep/training will take place on Sunday afternoon. This will be for their specific area of ministry throughout the week. Help them become comfortable sharing the gospel or their personal testimony.
